Results are based on respondents to Holy Family University's Recent Graduate Survey. The Recent Graduate Survey was administered during the Spring 2023 semester to those Holy Family University students who graduated within the three prior years. In total, 1,663 graduates received an invitation to the Recent Graduate Survey. The following tables are based on the 102 responses received from this population.¹

Job Placement Rates

91.7% of graduates are currently working for pay, with an average salary of \$74,140.
